



SEARCH TIPS:


We try to include **important key words** in our file names. When you search, think about **the main idea the resource addresses** (reward, data, culturally responsive, restraint, etc.).

Try to use complete words in your search instead of acronyms. If you use an acronym, the system will return resources with that character string in their title. For example, a search of "SEL" would produce "SEL and Behavior Resource Catalog" as well as "Baseline Data Entry Form."

Avoid using numbers in your search (such as "Tier 1," "Tier 2," and "Tier 3") because the system has a hard time distinguishing single numbers from number strings (e.g., "2019").

The Resource Spotlight includes a search feature that looks across all of our webpages and binders. If you know the title of the resource you're looking for, it will be included in the search results along with other resources that contain those words in their titles.
